The published papers will appear in print and online via *Radiocarbon*'s Cambridge Core site (<a href="http://cambridge.org/RDC">http://cambridge.org/RDC</a>).

The Proceedings should be published by the end of 2027. More details will be provided upon submission of a manuscript. ## **Important**

Proceedings articles will be published (non-OA) free of charge to participants, but due to the high number of submissions expected, *length restrictions will apply* to all submissions. Authors may choose to publish their articles in OA format at their own cost or through a Read and Publish agreement.

Please limit your manuscript to 4500 words and 4 figures, which calculates to roughly 8 printed pages. To avoid excess pages, authors of longer papers are encouraged to submit some tables, figures, and/or data as free online supplemental material.
