The published papers will appear in print and online via *Radiocarbon*'s Cambridge Core site (<http://cambridge.org/RDC>).

## Important

Proceedings articles will be published (non-OA) free of charge to participants, but due to the high number of submissions expected, *length restrictions will apply* to all submissions. Authors may choose to publish their articles in OA format at their own cost or through a Read and Publish agreement.

Please limit your manuscript to *4500 words* and *4 figures*, which calculates to roughly 8 printed pages. To avoid excess pages, authors of longer papers are encouraged to submit some tables, figures, and/or data as free online supplemental material.
